### Young Dancer Ballet Camps/Classes

ARB Level 2 and Level 3 Students (Ages 6 - 9)

Daily classes will include basic Stretch/Conditioning, Ballet Technique, Beginning Tap, Ballet History, Pre Pointe.

### Princess & Prince Ballet Camps/Classes

ARB Levels Pre-Ballet thru Level 1 (Ages 4-7)

Our programs have weekly ballet themes and feature daily ballet class, craft, ballet theme choreography, and lots of fun! Designed for PreK - 1st Grade with a Different Theme for each Week each Month!

### Monthly Themes for 2022

**June:** Come dance as Odette or her Prince! Experience the enchanting story of Swan Lake, a tale of a Prince and Swan Queen's love, a dazzling royal ball, and victory! Dancers will explore one of the most iconic ballets, which happens to be Tchaikovsky's first ballet music score! Students will receive daily ballet class, fun history lessons, crafts and activities, and an end of camp performance.

**July:** Bring your favorite doll to a week of fun filled dancing inspired by history during the eras of historic American Girl dolls! Learn about ballet folkloric with Josefina in 1824, the development of the first professional U.S. ballet companies with Kit in the 1930s and tap during the 1950s with Maryellen! Dancers will receive daily ballet class, learn cultural and historic dances, engage in fun history lessons, crafts and activities, and an end of camp performance! (Note: this year's camp will focus on new dance history. If you joined us last year, come again for a new experience!)

**August:** You know the story behind the beloved ballet and recognize its music, but do you know the history of behind it and the quirky elements of the original story? Come experience the nutcracker like never before as we unpack fun facts about the tale and learn choreography from our very own production! We will also have a nutcracker tea party where dancers will taste sweets from the countries represented in Act 2! Students will receive daily ballet class, fun history lessons, crafts and activities, and an end of camp performance! (Note: If you joined us last year, come again to learn new facts and focus on different aspects of the ballet!)

## Tap Camp

### Beginner Tap Camp

ARB Levels 1 thru Level 4

Tap- This is an introductory camp perfect for those who are thinking to join tap in the fall! Dancers will learn basic tap steps, the history of tap dancing, and about the pioneers who created tap as a distinct dance style. Current tap students are also welcome to join in order to brush up on the basics and learn tap history! (We have quite a few tap shoes for students to borrow if they'd like to try tap before officially buying shoes!)
